#### Project Description:

The Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District ("District") acting as lead agency for Axia Cooperative, sought proposals from qualified firms in response to this Request for Proposals ("RFP") for Microsoft and VMware Professional Services (the "Services"). Golden Gate Bridge Highway & Transportation District issued RFP #2023-D-006 April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023, to establish a comprehensive national cooperative contract for Microsoft and VMWare on-call Professional Services.

Services requested include, but are not limited to the following:

- Strategize – Align business and IT objectives; quantify benefits, develop IT strategy
- Assess – Identify current and future states; enhance people, process, and platform readiness
- Design – Create the solution design, integration plans, and operating procedures
- Deploy – Implement, integrate, configure, test, and validate the overall solution design
- Optimize – Analyze and improve the existing environment and transfer best practice knowledge

The solicitation included cooperative purchasing language in the Background Section:

**Axia Cooperative Information** - The District, as the Lead Procurement Agency, as defined in Attachment J, has partnered with Axia Coop LLC (“Axia Cooperative”) to make the contract resulting from this solicitation (also known as the “Master Agreement” in materials distributed by Axia Cooperative) available to other public agencies nationally, including state and local governmental entities, public and private primary, secondary and higher education entities, non-profit entities, and agencies for the public benefit (“Public Agencies”), through Axia Cooperative’s cooperative purchasing program. In order to use the Master Agreement a Public Agency must be registered with Axia Cooperative as a Participating Public Agency in Axia Cooperative’s cooperative purchasing program. Attachment J contains additional information on Axia Cooperative and the cooperative purchasing agreement.

Notice of the solicitation was publicly posted on the Golden Gate Bridge Highway and Transportation District’s website and emailed to all registered vendors who have indicated that email is their preferred delivery method. The solicitation was also advertised in the following:

The proposals were evaluated by an evaluation committee. Using the evaluation criteria established in the RFP, the committee elected to enter negotiations with **Zones** and proceed to contract award upon successful completion of negotiations.

The Golden Gate Bridge Highway & Transportation District, Axia Cooperative, and **Zones** successfully negotiated a contract, which was executed with a contract effective date of March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

Term:

The term of the Contract shall commence upon award and shall remain in effect for a period of three (3) years, unless terminated, canceled, or extended as otherwise provided. The Golden Gate Bridge Highway & Transportation District shall have the right, at its sole option, to renew the Contract for two (2) additional one-year periods or portions thereof.
